

ADDITIONAL PROTOCOL INFORMATION FOR SCORERS
--

- England Netball Score Cards will be issued to Scorers when they 'Sign In' on arrival.
- All Scorers will be issued with identification badges for easy recognition on the courtside.
- Scorers will score their own teams matches throughout the Tournament
- Scorers **must not** be involved with their Team Bench throughout the game.
- Scorers **must neither** coach or encourage their team during the game. Failure to abide by this regulation will be notified to the Tournament Referee.
- Both Scorers will stand and work together, at a place designated by the Court Manager. This could be either on the sideline or goal-line dependent upon health & safety for everybody courtside.
- Both Scorers will record each goal scored on the issued Score Card. One Scorer will "call" the score after each goal, who this will be, should be agreed prior to the commencement of the game.
- On the final whistle ensure that your Team Captain accompanies you to the Umpire in order for Score Card to be promptly completed by inserting the Final Score which will be the Official Score for the match. The Score Card then has to be signed then counter signed by the Team Captains. The Umpire will record their name on the Score Card as the officiating Umpire.
- If a Team arrives on court late, the name of the Team and the time they arrived will be recorded on the Score Card by the Umpires, **prior** to the commencement of play, as they are controlling the game. The Court Manager will record these details on her Log.

SCORECARDS AND SCORING

Remember 2 x Evens = Even; 2 x Odds = Even; 1 x Even + 1 x Odd = Odd

2nd Quarter

If at the end of the first quarter the ball is still in play change the Odds and Evens over. It will then mean that Red will take the Centre Pass at the start of the 2nd quarter

3rd Quarter

If at the end of the second quarter the Centre Pass has not been taken move the Evens and Odds straight down. It will be a Blue Centre Pass

Remember to be consistent when calling the score at a Centre Pass:-

Blue Centre, Red lead 10-3
Pass

10-3 to Red – Blue Centre

Red Centre, they lead 10-3

10-4 to Blue – Blue Centre Pass
